To make the first tassel, wrap yarn around the cardboard 15 times.



Cut a 10-inch piece of yarn and thread through the top of yarn wrap.



Tie a knot and cut bottom loop..



yarn around the top of tassel four times; then secure with a knot.








When the glue is dry, flip over and decorate with mini-pompoms and a star.



# BALL OF JOY ORNAMENT A simple ornament made by stacking eight half circles. TIPS • Mix up the amount of circles used to create a more dense or sparse ball. • Use different paper for a more whimsical effect.

tape helps secure




